

OUR SHEPHERD LUTHERAN SCHOOL Kindergarten School Supply List 2019-2020

Your child should bring these supplies on <u>July 30</u> to the student orientation appointment.

<u>Do not print your child's name on these supplies.</u> I will print your child's name on the items using the <u>correct handwriting formation that I want your child to use in kindergarten.</u> Thanks. We will put these items directly into your child's basket which I will have labeled with your child's name.

Please bring the following to your child's appointment on July 30:

2 packs of <u>Crayola</u> crayons that contain 24 crayons (<u>Do not get washable crayons.</u>)

1 pack of Crayola wide markers that contain 10 - 12 Classic colors

1 pack of <u>Crayola</u> thin markers that contain 10 - 12 <u>Classic</u> colors

18 Elmer's glue sticks (regular size, not jumbo)

2 bottles of Elmer's school glue, 4 oz.

1 dozen #2 lead <u>Ticonderoga</u> pencils (<u>sharpened</u>)

1 pair of Fiskars blunt-edged school scissors

1 box of Kleenex

1 spray bottle of 409 or Lysol brand all purpose cleaning spray that kills germs

1 regular-sized pencil box (no larger than 9"x6"x2 ½") (The hard plastic ones actually work the best.)

1 set of <u>Crayola</u> watercolor paints (basic set containing 8 classic colors)

1 paint shirt (An old t-shirt that is a little larger than your child's size works well.)

1 roll of paper towels (Later in the year, I will send out a note when more rolls are needed.)

1 box of Ziplock quart size bags

1 box of Ziplock gallon size bags

The following school supplies need to be brought to school daily starting on August 7.

- 1 backpack/bookbag that can easily hold your child's 9"x12" folder, art papers, etc.(Do not bring small backpacks that are unable to hold folders, large art papers, etc.)
- 1 9"x12" pocket folder that your child will use to take home papers in backpack.
- 1 lunchbox used on days your child brings his/her lunch to school (Lunches will also be available for purchase daily from the school. Please see details from the school office or inquire at registration which will also be held on July 30.)

1 pair of appropriate shoes and socks that will be worn to and from school daily. Tennis shoes are preferred daily so that kids can play both inside and outside. They will not be left at school unless we notice that your child does not have appropriate shoes for running, jumping, etc.

Also, your child may bring a healthy snack daily that is placed into the front small pocket of the backpack. Do not place this in the lunch box. (No sugary drinks, chips, cookies, or candy please.)
